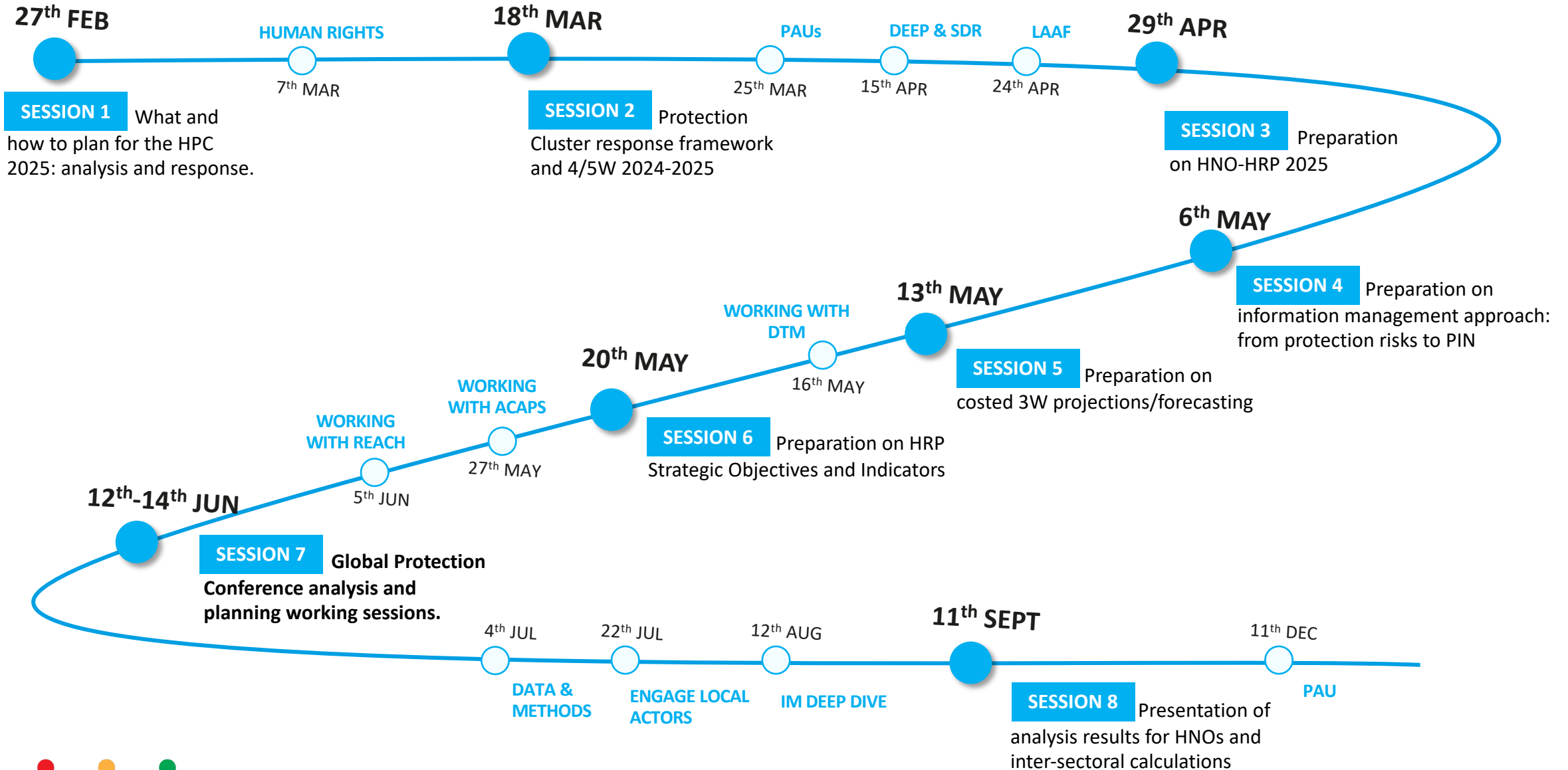

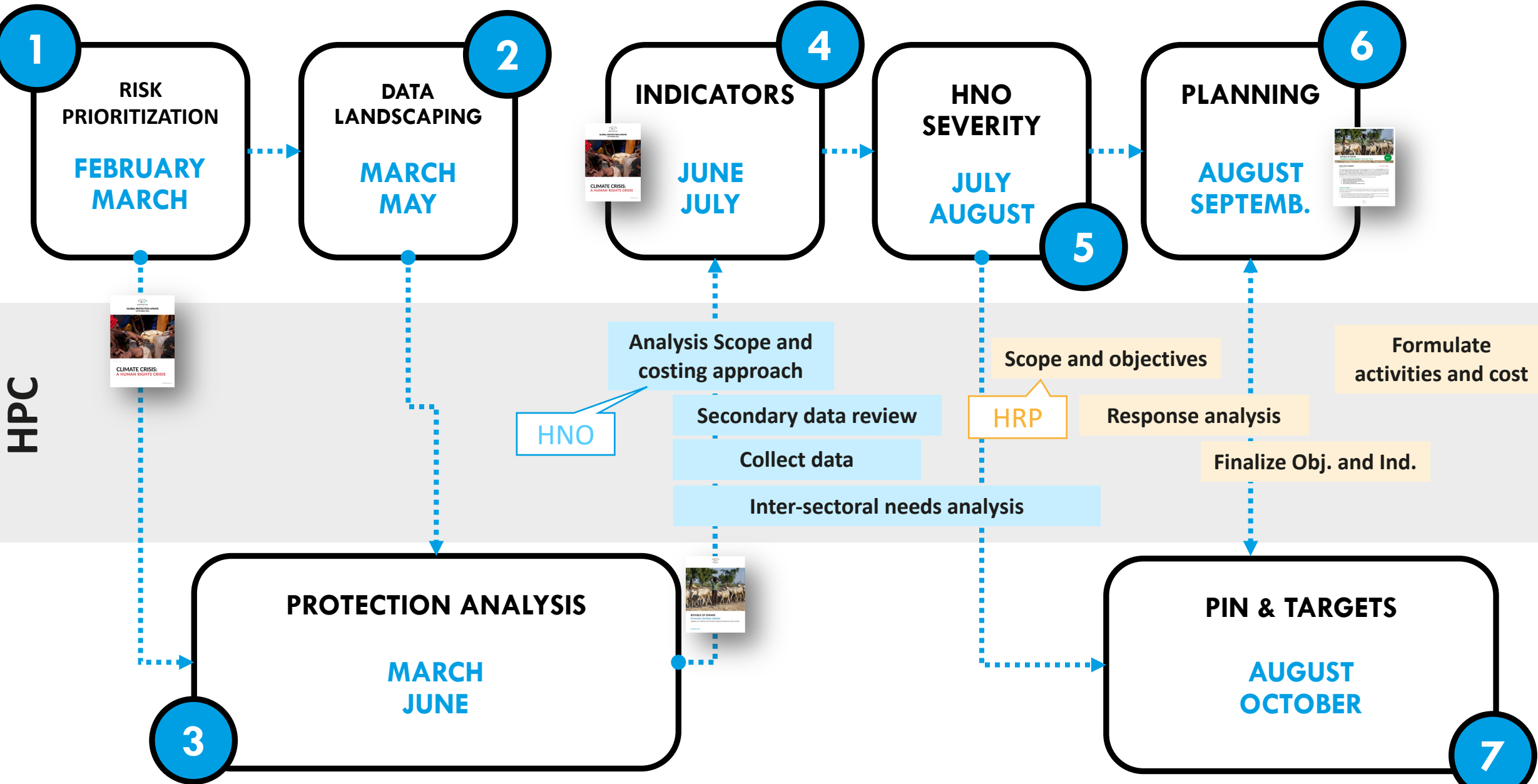
# Objectives of today's session

# STEP 1: Protection Risk prioritization



**WHAT:** Collect severity of 15 protection risks to define the top 5.



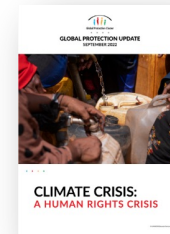
**HOW:**

- Kobo survey severity of 15 protection risks
- Short sessions to discuss results (subnational is recommended) and pre-identified top 5

# STEP 2: Information and data landscaping



**WHAT:** Identification of data available, needs and gaps against Protection Indicators databank



**HOW:**

- PAF data landscaping for priority protection risks
- Standard agenda item in Protection meetings (as minimum)
- Consultation to decide quantitative vs. qualitative



**SUGGESTED PRODUCT:**

- Collective PAF secondary data review mapping against PR IM tool

# STEP 3: Protection Analysis



**WHAT:** Agreement on priority Protection Risks



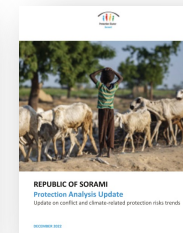
**HOW:**

- Minimum: Two half-day sessions operational partners (1. Prioritization. 2. Validation and update of the analysis)
- Suggested: Subnational prioritization sessions based on GPU survey. National sessions for validation

# STEP 4: Elaboration of HNO indicators

**WHAT:** Verify coherence of 2024 indicators and define approach for each 2025 selected indicator.

**HOW:**

- IM technical verification of “*doability*” for each indicator
- Joint session or dedicated PC meeting to agree on the approach for each selected indicator (i.e. quantitative vs. qualitative, primary vs secondary data)

**SUGGESTED PRODUCT:**

- Recommendation document on data/information approach and needs/gaps

# STEP 5: Severity of Protection Risks and Needs



**WHAT:** Finalization of protection risks and needs severity, and analysis for JIAF 2.0



**HOW:**

- IM provision of a) Aggregated PR severity and b) Calculation of severity from selected indicators
- Minimum: Joint sessions to present results, and expert judgement based on Protection Risks severity criteria

- IM 1 pager on methodology for HNOs

**WHAT:** Strategic mapping of partners geographic coverage and actions



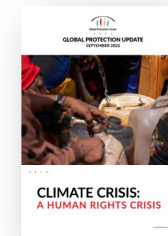
**HOW:**

- Suggested: 2 half a day sessions, a) Partners intentions against priority protection risks, b) partners projected presence and planning.

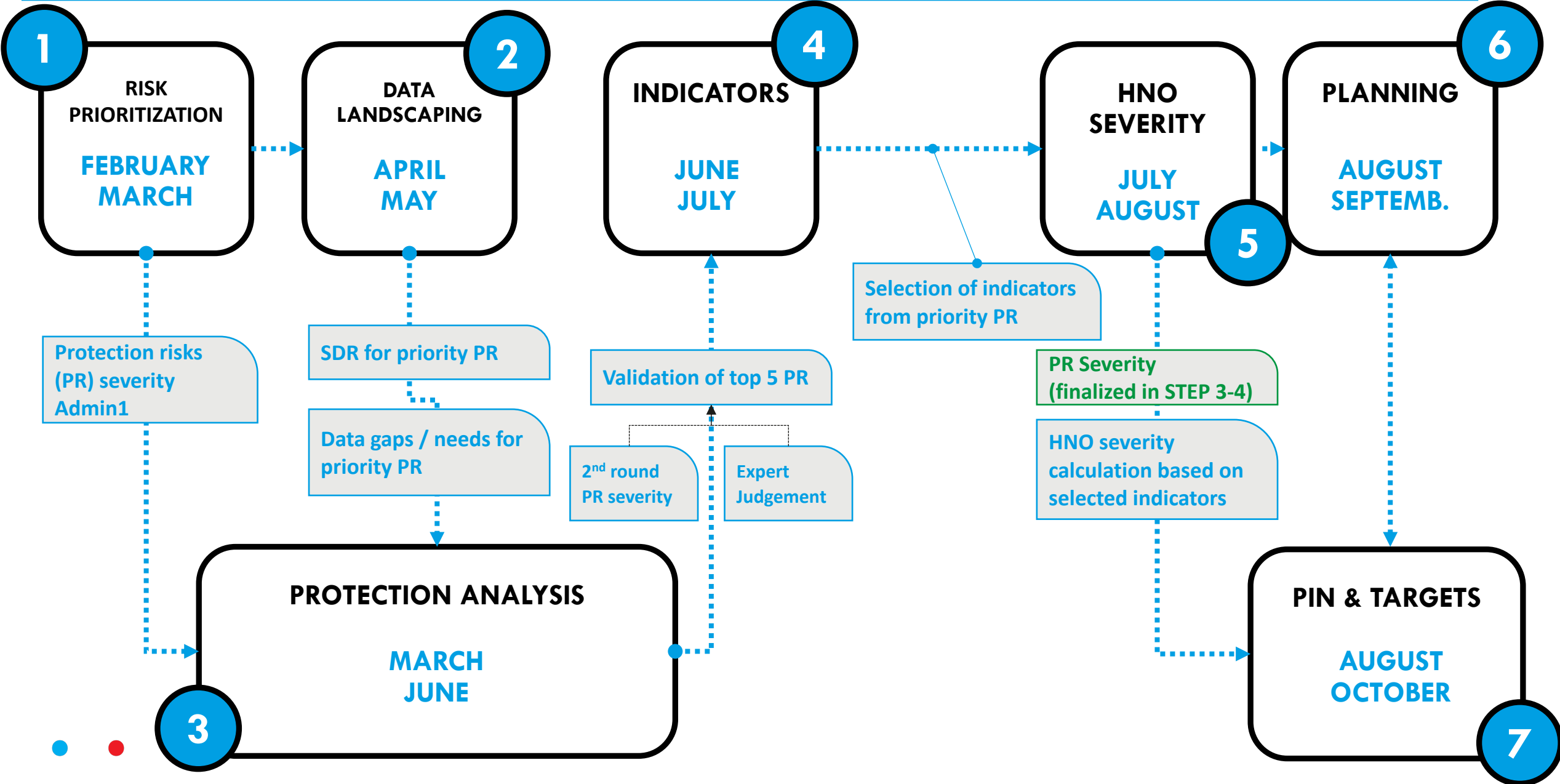

# Core messages

- ✓ **Protection risks severity and prioritization** inform the HPC process.
- ✓ Protection cluster inputs a) To HNO scope and b) Sector specific sections
- ✓ The **GPU** quarterly survey supports consultative processes at country level
- ✓ The decision on **number and timing of PAUs** is strategically defined with SAG and partners.
- ✓ **Information management colleagues to be more engaged on GPU and PAU** to anticipate specific HNO and HRP processes.
- ✓ Reach out to GPC Focal Points or Lisa Monaghan to support adaptation (**do not get stuck, we need to be flexible**)
