CONTEXTS

JAPAN – Soka Gakkai response

- Location of activities: Tohoku region - Iwate, Miyagi and Fukushima Prefecture
- Timeframe: March 11, 2011 - ongoing
- Main protection concerns: psychosocial care

IRAQI KURDISTAN – CAPNI response

- Location of activities: Duhok province (IDPs) + Nineveh Plains (IDPs and returnees)
- Timeframe: August 2014 - ongoing
- Main protection concerns: right to education

SOMALIA – Islamic Relief Response


- Location of activities: Somaliland (Borama, Hargeisa, Salah ley); South Central (Baidoa, Banadir, Beledweyn, Afgooye, Balcad); Puntland (Qardo, Badan, Garowe)
- Timeframe: started 2006 – ongoing
- Main protection concerns: GBV/ Forced early marriages / Child recruitments into armed forces

HIAS – regional response – LAC

- Location of activities: 9 in Latin America & the Caribbean
- Timeframe: Since 2003
- Main protection concerns: Community based MHPSS, GBV prevention and response, economic inclusion, legal protection



Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011



All the 600km coastal area was hit by tsunami.

Death toll: Nearly 16,000

Missing: Nearly 3,000

Number of evacuees: 500,000

42 culture centers accommodated 5,000 evacuees

Taskforce teams conducted home-visits, providing medical services, clean-up, ride service and so on

Fukushima Daiichi
Nuclear Power Plant
